The Aztec name for a Tongue Drum is Teponatzli. Easy to play, durable, free-tuned Tongue Drum. Fun to play and very versatile. What other drum already has 8 tones right from the beginning?

Comes with two mallets.

- TE-4** 4 tones, 16 x 4.8 x 4.8 inch
- TE-6** 6 tones, 18 x 6.8 x 5.6 inch
- TE-8** 8 tones, 25 x 8 x 6 inch



Tongue Drum

The precisely pentatonic-tuned Profiline Tongue Drum can be used as a rhythm and melody instrument.

Comes with two mallets.

- P-6TP** Piccolo, 6 tones-pentatonic
C maj c'-c'', 18 x 6.8 x 5.2 inch
- S-8TP** Sopran, 8 tones-pentatonic
F maj f-a', 24 x 8 x 7.2 inch
- S-12TP** Sopran, 12 tones-diatonic
F maj d-a', 28 x 9.6 x 7.6 inch





Tongue Drum, Bass

Ideal to play with small and big people. The vibration can be felt very comfortable throughout the body. All slitdrums have an additional pair of feet on the side enabling them to be flipped over 90 degrees.

Comes with 2 mallets.

- B-4TK** Bass, 4 tones,
C maj c-c', 32 x 12 x 14 inch
- T-8TP** Tenor, 8 tones
D pentatonic: A-d', 40 x 12 x 14 inch
- B-8TP** Bass-8 tones
D pentatonic: D-g, 48 x 17.2 x 18.8 inch
